LETTER CRAFT: "C is for Caterpillar"

Time Needed: 25 minutes

Materials Needed:

- One large capital letter C per student (printed on paper)
- Colorful pom-poms in various colors
- Googly eyes
- Glue sticks
- Crayons or markers for coloring

Instructions:

1. Color the Letter C:

o Start by using crayons or markers to color the big letter C. You can color it any way you like! Be creative and make it colorful!

2. Glue the Fuzzy Balls:

o Take the colorful fuzzy balls (pom-poms) and glue them onto the C. Start at the bottom of the letter and glue the first ball at the curve. Then, glue the rest of the fuzzy balls in a line, making your caterpillar's body. You can use different colors for each ball to make your caterpillar bright and fun!

3. Add the Googly Eyes:

Take the googly eyes and glue them onto the first fuzzy ball (the head of the caterpillar). You can place the eyes anywhere on the ball, but it's fun to put them near the top!

4. Let it Dry:

o After you've glued all the balls and the googly eyes, let your caterpillar dry for a few minutes so the glue sticks well.

5. Show Off Your Caterpillar:

o Now you have your very own **Caterpillar** made out of a **C**! Share your awesome craft with your friends and teacher/parent!
